In the past 16 months, Westminster Wheels has provided **30** London Living Wage work placements for unemployed residents from diverse backgrounds.

Following accredited bike mechanic training, our trainees work alongside experienced bike mechanics to develop their skills.

In the next **6** months, our aim is to provide **13** placements for unemployed residents.

SPONSOR A REFURBISHED BIKE TO DONATE TO OUR COMMUNITY

Active transport & vibrant communities



Bikes donated by Westminster Wheels are targeted at areas in the City with the highest rates of deprivation, unemployment and need in terms of poor health.

From April to December 2022, our aim is to refurbish and donate 250 bikes to the community through referrals from front line services and charities.

60% of our bikes we donate are for young people, reflecting the nature of the bikes donated to the project

Inclusion, training & employment



To mitigate the cost-of-living crisis and to encourage, active transport in our most diverse communities, Westminster Wheels will offer bike servicing vouchers for low-income families.

In the next 6 months, our aim is to offer 450 bike servicing vouchers to encourage residents to cycle.

Vouchers will be distributed through our shop and community organisations and Council service teams.
