

Musician's Code of Conduct

In order to ensure the safety of our staff, couples and their guests, we are committed to complying with the <u>Government's Covid Secure guidelines</u>. As a result, we would ask all musicians attending ceremonies at Old Marylebone Town Hall or Mayfair Library abide by the following code of conduct:

- 1. Ensure you wash / sanitise your hands regularly, but particularly on arrival and exit, and before you touch any furniture, fixtures of fittings within the venue.
- 2. Maintain 2m distance at all times from registrars, ushers and venue staff.
- 3. Please arrive ready to play there is no capacity to offer preparation space / time to practice or warm up at either venue. We do not have changing space either.
- 4. At the Old Marylebone Town Hall the maximum number of musicians allowed is four e.g. a string quartet. This is applicable to the Westminster Room only.
- 5. At Mayfair Library the maximum number of musicians allowed is two. This is applicable to the Mayfair Room only.
- 6. Instruments should be confined to those than can be held, and require no set up space or time.
- 7. In line with Government guidelines, no blown instruments can be played, and no singing is permitted.
- 8. Please follow any instructions given by registrars, ushers or venue staff. Please respect their responsibility to maintaining a safe venue.

Please note – failure to abide by this Code of Conduct may result in you being asked to leave the venue immediately or impact on the ability for the ceremony to continue. It may also result in you being banned from performing at the Town Hall or Library in the future.
